Digital assets that form part of your legacy can be categorised into four main sections:

- Financial assets For example: PayPal, online banking, gaming sites, gambling, lottery sites, frequent flyer programs.
- Sentimental assets For example: Flickr, Picassa, YouTube, Photobucket, diary sites, Instagram.
- Intellectual assets For example: Email, developed code, websites, blog content, Google docs, web URLs, Dropbox.
- Social assets

For example: Twitter, Facebook, MySpace, LinkedIn, Google Plus.

Digital assets are not satisfactorily covered in traditional wills due to the dynamic nature of online activity.
